## Do you have a DEVELOP ID# yet? develop

MNSTREAMS IS CONVERTING TO **DEVELOP:** 

The MNStreams will no longer be available after June 30, 2016, which means your training record will no longer be available unless you convert your files to DEVELOP. If you have ever taken a training through Child Care Aware/Think Small, you have a training record on MNStreams. Here are a few easy steps::

1. Create a DEVELOP account

- 2. Go to www.developmn.org log in and click "Create Individual Account"
- 3. Enter the DEVELOP ID account # into vour MNStreams account (www.mnstream.org) to create the automatic transfer of your data.

Having a DEVELOP ID# will allow you to have all of your training hours on one transcript.
